Since 1986 Ghent University awards Sarton Medals to outstanding historians of science in various scientific disciplines.

Professor Michel De Vroey teaches 'History of economic thought' at the Université catholique de Louvain (UCL). He is internationally renowned for his research into the history of macroeconomics, in particular the macroeconomics of Keynes and Lucas. He published numerous articles and books on Keynesian and new classical macroeconomics. He was a visiting professor at many European and North American universities.
